

## AirBerth donates boatlifts to two WA volunteer groups

Western Australian sea rescue groups rely on grants, donations and fund raising to meet operational expenses. Having their new sea rescue vessels on the AirBerth boatlift will provide substantial benefits to the volunteer groups by

avoiding the need for anti-fouling, ongoing hull maintenance and ensuring the vessels are ready for deployment with clean hulls for maximum performance.

Volunteers can devote more time and resources to training and education rather than on maintenance, and the life expectancy of the vessel and engines is expected to be substantially increased along with the value of the vessel.
