

# AirBerth boat lift system

## Our Review

Recently seen in the UK is this the Australian-made Airberth. It is like a floating dry dock with round tubes in a catamaran configuration. You drive your boat into the supports between the floats while its partly submerged. Compressed air is then used to displace the water from the tubes. The tubes are made out of polyethylene and are robust and will not corrode.

One of the features of AirBerth is that it is self contained. You do not need to make alterations to your slip or berth. You just park the AirBerth in the slip, and with the blower box, you pump air into the tubes, thereby lifting the boat clear of the water, and hence any fouling and growth.

There are distributors in most countries including down under, Europe and the US. This is not a new products and its been around for a few years with a proven track record.

Prices start at over £16,000 plus for the 1.5-ton M 150 lift, and extend to £20,000 plus for the ten-ton M 1000 Model. You will need to keep the lift for a while before it starts paying for itself. However eventually your boat is free from osmosis and electrolysis and you do not need to antifoul.
