The AirBerth Boat Lift provides an effective solution that streamlines the issues of vessel down time and the inefficiencies of regulatory maintenance. It serves the dual function of keeping the boat safely stored out of the water when not in use, while at the same time permitting rapid vessel deployment when needed. The AirBerth is designed and engineered with simplicity in mind. It's just a matter of pointing the bow between the two mooring guides; with AirBerth claiming the boat will self centre in even the most testing conditions.

Only high-quality components were sourced and developed into the AirBerth, from the patented flexible cradle system which enables the cradle to shape to the hull providing optimum loading support as the boat rises, to the implementation of world class Ronstan pulleys to ensure ease of operation every time, and compression pads which give cushioned support towards the transom to eliminate the issues of point loading.

The AirBerth is constructed of High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) materials which are non corrosive and have the highest UV stability. The focus on quality materials has resulted in the product



having a claimed estimated lifespan of 50 years plus.

There are 10 standard models in the AirBerth range, from 1,500kg up to 11,000kg, with models engineered to suite both mono-hull planing and power catamarans.

"From our ongoing feedback with our commercial clients to date, the overwhelmingly positive response is that the addition of the AirBerth has greatly enhanced their day-to-day operations, with reduced maintenance and increased productivity these vital resources can be allocated to other areas within the organisations", commented National Marketing Manager Justin Lye.
